

Race Number collection

- Please ensure you have your Zimbabwean ID/ or passport and proof of residency if SADC, proof of payment / entry to the Team Relay Collection Desk
- If you are collecting for a third party – above will be required for each athlete, together with their permission for you to collect on their behalf.
- You will receive a baton along with your race numbers. **DO NOT LOSE THIS BATON** as it houses your chip that will record your time.
- The first [Starting Runner] is to keep this baton with them and need to carry it and hand it over to the second runner at the transition point. Without this – you have no timed result.
- Please make sure you decide in advance who is running the first 10.5km from the START to the transition point and who is running second lap from the Transition point to the FINISH.



Race Day -

NOTE: All 2nd Runners, you are to **be at The Baobab Primary School by 6h15am**. You can watch the start of the full Marathon [6h15am] but need to walk down the finish line strait towards the gate on Dale Crescent, that is directly opposite the START /FINISH ARCH to catch your bus asap, thereafter, as the buses depart at 6h30am. Staff will be holding up signage with torches to highlight the direction of the bus collection area, please look out for these directional boards.

- **Buses depart for the transition point at 6h30am latest.** Way before the start of the Team Relay.
- Please ensure you have your Team Relay Race Number on to allow you access onto the buses.
- The Transition point is 10.5km from the START - it will be clearly identifiable by the Team Relay Branding and a big tent.
- For these runners who are delivered early via the transfers, refreshments will be available there while you wait for your team mates to arrive
- **Please keep off the road at the transition point as the full marathon runners will come flying past way before your team mates come through.** Expect your runners to arrive round 7h15am at the earliest.
- Please note, the 2nd Runners, who will do the 2nd half into the Finish area, will receive 2 Medals [one for each team member] as they cross the line. Please make sure you give your team mate their well-deserved Medal 😊

All Starting [1st Runners]

The Relay has its own START TIME at 06h45am, from the main start line at the Baobab Primary School.

It follows the same route as the Half Marathon throughout

The Transition point, is at approximately 10.5km, you will see the branded Remit Hope Transition point clearly marked

It is here that you hand over your baton to your team member to complete the course.

- Buses will transport all first runners at regular intervals from the Transition point back to the finish grounds at Baobab Primary School
- There will be refreshments available at the transition point for all relay runners

Please note there will be prize giving at approximately 10h30 on the Stage at the Finish Area for the following categories, you have to be at the finish to get your prize:

- First Winning Female Team in
- First Winning Male Team in
- First Mixed Team in
